Conditions of Entry

Please read and take special note of entry fee payment requirements.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. It is expected that players will have read and are familiar with the 'Conditions of Entry' prior to submitting an entry.
- 2. This tournament is for all Club and School players who have not been a Bay of Plenty Representative player in the last 24 months.
- 3. Players must be U13, U15, U17 or U19 as at 31 December 2024. Age groups may be combined if not enough entries are not received for an age group.
- 4. Players may only enter a maximum of 2 events, singles, and doubles.

Rules of Play

- 5. The BWF scoring system will be used.
- 6. This event will be played using the Alternative Service Law 9.1.6. The whole of the shuttle shall be below the server's waist at the instant of being hit by the server's racket. The waist shall be considered to be an imaginary line round the body, level with the lowest part of the server's bottom rib, and; the shaft and racket head of the server's racket at the instant of hitting the shuttle shall be pointing in a downward direction.
- 7. All questions as to the rules shall be resolved by an appointed tournament official.

Player Requirements

- 8. Players must ensure that the tournament organiser is advised if they wish to leave the hall.
- 9. All players must act as umpires or line judges when requested. Failure to do so may result in the player being defaulted. Please check the websites prior to the session for player umpires (if needed).
- 10. Players compete at their own risk. No responsibility will be accepted for any injury received during this tournament.

Entry Fees

- 11. The entry fee must be in the Bay of Plenty Badminton Association Bank Account no later than Monday 22nd April 2024.
- 12. Please allow at least 2 working days for payments to be processed through the banking system.
